**Camp Fee: HKD\$16,000\* / \$17,600**




## ACTIVIDADES

### Córdoba

Córdoba is a living tapestry of ancient history. It is celebrated for its enchanting floral patios adorning whitewashed streets and its magnificent monuments, like the legendary Mosque-Cathedral, that stand as timeless testaments to its storied past.



### Seville

Seville is the passionate soul of Spain. A city of intoxicating beauty, where orange trees scent the air, flamenco rhythms echo in cobbled alleyways, and monumental landmarks like the soaring Gothic cathedral and the majestic Alcázar palace tell tales of a glorious past. This is Andalusia at its most vivid and alive.



### Ronda

Perched atop a breathtaking gorge, Ronda is one of Spain's most spectacular and iconic towns. Its defining feature is the Puente Nuevo—a monumental bridge that spans the 100-meter-deep El Tajo Gorge, dramatically connecting its historic Moorish quarter with the newer 18th-century town.





## Camino del Rey

El Caminito del Rey is one of Spain's most thrilling and spectacular hikes. Once considered the world's most dangerous walkway, this vertigo-inducing cliffside path has been safely restored. It winds through the dramatic Desfiladero de los Gaitanes gorge, offering heart-stopping views of limestone cliffs, a rushing river far below, and a unique perspective on Andalusia's raw natural beauty.



## Málaga

Málaga, the capital of the Costa del Sol, is a sun-soaked blend of ancient history and contemporary culture. Beyond its popular beaches, discover a historic core dominated by the hilltop Alcazaba fortress, the Renaissance cathedral, and the birth place of Pablo Picasso.





## KAYAK / PADEL SURF

The day will begin with the sun shining on the Iznájar reservoir and with fun activities like kayaking and paddle surfing surrounded by stunning natural scenery. Campers will explore the calm waters and improve their coordination and balance through these activities.



## Paintball / Rappelling / Team Building

Equipped with vests and masks, we'll have a fun paintball battle. Campers will work as a team, devise clever tactics, and release their energy in a fun-filled game.

They will also do rappelling and team building, which are cooperative games where they will work together to solve challenges and achieve goals.


